Functions of the Committee:


- The Grievances committee deals with the grievances of teaching faculty, other employees and the students.




Points discussed:

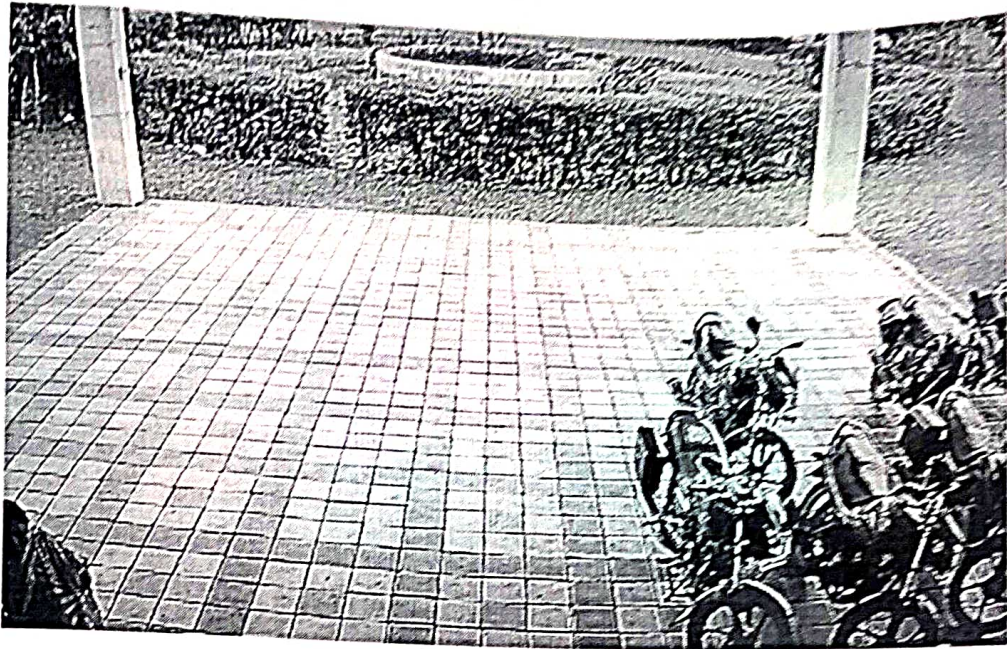
CCTV FACILITIES AT COLLEGE CAMPUS



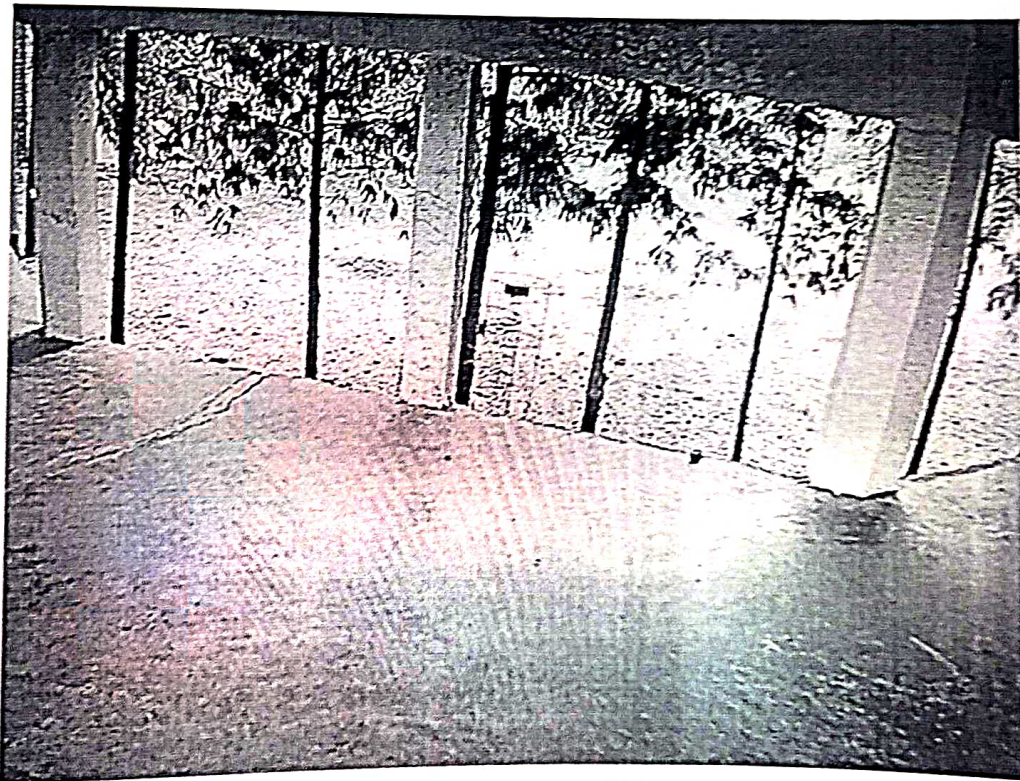
Surveillance of CCTV monitoring in Principal's Cabin
